He also expressed getting it into the hands of 8th graders and parents. Could be used as a membership driving tool.

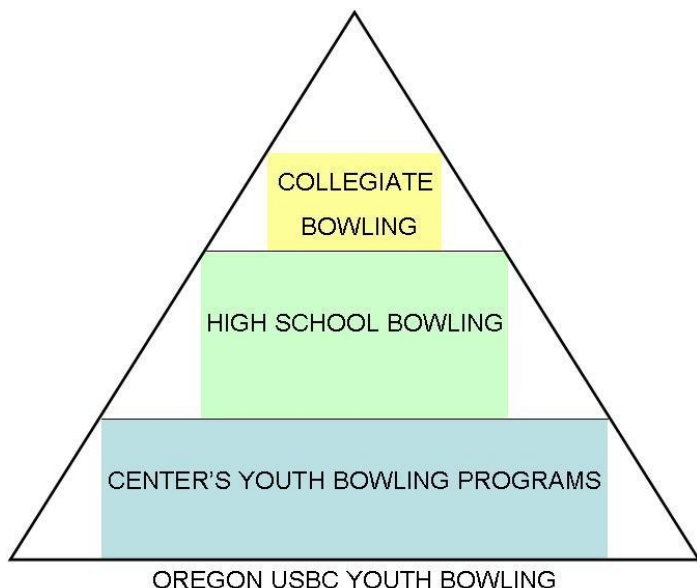
