Coach Background Check & Approval Verification – REQUIRED!

All coaches must provide verification that they have undergone a recent background check and are approved to coach by either:

- 1) The United States Bowling Congress (USBC) Registered Volunteer Program – www.bowl.com
- 2) The Oregon High School for which they coach bowling
- 3) Oregon jurisdiction (i.e. State of Oregon, County, or City)

Proof of background check must be submitted with entry form.

OSUSBC District Managers will keep record of coaches' background verification on hand at all OSUSBC certified tournaments.

Acceptable proof of background check:

- 1) USBC Registered Volunteer Program – copy of your current certificate or letter/email from USBC Headquarters.
- 2) Oregon High School verification on this form or a separate letter on school letterhead. Must be signed by athletic/activity director or school official.
- 3) Signed and dated verification by other appropriate Oregon jurisdiction (separate letter on appropriate letterhead).
