If you wish to be part of a team that sets the example for the rest of the Mid Valley we have several committee openings.

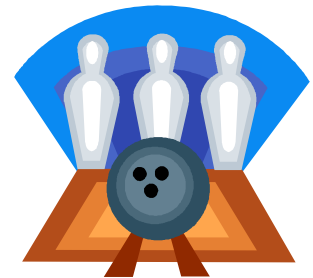
Tournament committee has 2 openings. The committee is responsible for checking for local youth tournaments, helping organizing the fun
